REGULATIONS & INTEGRITY:

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the General Competition regulations of the BWF as well as with the Badminton Europe U17 Circuit Regulations.

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).

Doping control in badminton, in acoordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted outof-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athlethes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). For more information about anti-doping, please visit the <u>BWF website</u>.

Clause 7.9 of BWF General Competition Regulations: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

ADVERTISING AND CLOTHING:

Advertising on clothing and colour of clothing shall be regulated by the BWF Competition Regulations and the U17 Circuit Regulations

ENTRIES:

All entries must be done via the BWF online entry system, by a BWF member association. Players can't be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

27th February 2024, 23:59 BWF Headquarters time (GMT +8). No late entries will be accepted.

DRAW:

Seeding and draw will be carried out by Badminton Europe.

DATE OF DRAW:

12th March 2024

WITHDRAWALS:

Players must contact the organizer immediately if they have to withdraw from the competition and inform about the reason(s) of withdrawal. All the withedraw requests before the WDN has to be done by the associations through online registration system. After the WDN deadline all withdrawals has to be send to info@juniorolvetournament.be.

§12.1. and 12.2. of the BEC U17 Circuit Regulations: The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC U17 Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payments at tournaments. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

Gold transport:

• Transport: 36.00 EUR

The gold transport option includes transport during the entire weekend (Friday -> Monday) from and to your hotel at any time you choose. However, for practical reasons, we do have to take a margin of 1h. e.g. if you come to us at 17h00 for transport to your hotel, we'll make sure a car/bus leaves at the sports hall at 18h00 at the latest. CATERING SERVICE:

Near the sports hall, we provide lunch and dinner for players, coaches, parents,... Lunch and/or dinner have to be ordered in advance. Keep in mind that there aren't many restaurants or eating establishments in the surroundings of the sports hall. Ordering meals during the tournament can be refused and it will be more expensive. Since we have to order food in advance, we can't refund food tickets at the tournament when you don't need them anymore.
